Submitted to our office no later than January 9, 2009

- If the applicant's related member's Elks Lodge is not San Mateo, the applicant's related member must be in good standing and this must be verified in writing by the Secretary of his or her Lodge.
- Applicants with a career goal in the field of **Education** may apply for the San Mateo Elks Lodge Education Scholarship.
- Applicants are to apply using the San Mateo Elks **OPEN** Scholarship Application form (available in the Lodge Office); there are no **financial requirements** for San Mateo Elks Family Scholarships.
- Your application must be in a paper folder with inside pockets and clasps. Three hole punch your application and secure it in the clasps. Your attachments must follow the order in the "[Instruction Check List](#)" on the last page of the "[Family Scholarship Application](#)".

AWARDS

Applicants receiving awards must supply documentation from the University of College of their choice that they are enrolled as a full-time student, and a check will be sent by the Lodge directly to the school.

Winners of the 2008-09 contest will be announced by **May 15, 2009**.
